

Preschool (ages 2-4)

This year we are using a preschool curriculum based on the basic belief that God loves and cares for each of us. Each lesson will actively engage every child in the Bible story, and lead them to experience God's love. Classes each Sunday involve playing in the Game Center, Art Center, Dramatic Play Center or Blocks Center, in addition to story telling, puppet time, and songs. We will begin the Sunday School year learning about Moses, Hannah, Samuel and David before moving to Jesus' birth, teachings, miracles and parables. We will end the year with the resurrection, the Early Church, Peter and Paul.

Kindergarten through 4th grade

The class begins with Creation and we move sequentially through major stories of Hebrew (Old) Scriptures to the Gospel Stories in late winter early spring. The year ends with celebrating the Birthday of the Church, Pentecost. Classes each Sunday involve several hands on activities as well as a prayer and story time. The multi age classroom allows older children to share what they have learned, helping them make the bible stories part of their faith development.

We have a new curriculum based on the lectionary text for the week. It is a full two years of the New Testament and will focus on how we try to live out our faith. Every spring we have an art show. The students get to pick their medium (clay, pastels, watercolors, etc) and recreate their favorite Bible story from the year.
